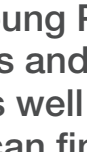

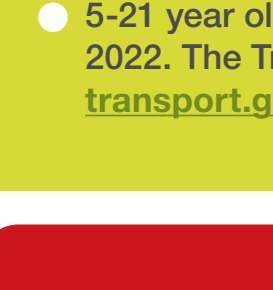

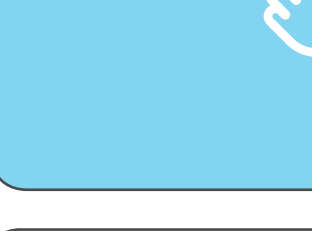


The Skills Training Network (STN) is the one-stop shop for employability programmes and support services in Dumfries and Galloway as well as programmes in other parts of Scotland.

Young Person's Agreement (16-18 year olds)

Not in education, training or employment? This is a funded programme of learning and activities personal to you, helping develop skills you need to access further training, education or employment opportunities. It qualifies you for ongoing Education Maintenance Allowance (EMA) if eligible and you continue to meet the terms of your agreement.

Employer Recruitment Incentive (ERI)

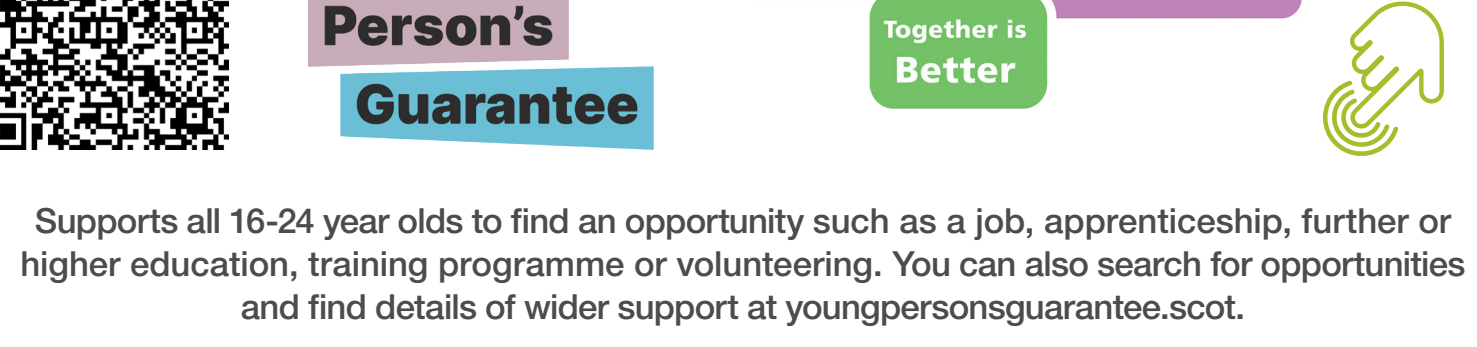
No work experience? Are you struggling to get a work placement or get started with work? A D&G training allowance may be available to you to encourage an employer to help you gain confidence, skills and knowledge while in a paid position within a local business.
